____Remove pets during photos and showings

____Replace burned out bulbs

___Open blinds and turn on lights and lamps, but turn fans off

____Have the house freshly and thoroughly cleaned, hire someone if you don't have the time! ____Clean

windows and doors, magic eraser around door knobs and on light switches ____Remove personal

photos, patch and paint holes left behind

____Also, now is the time to decide if there is anything attached to a wall or ceiling that you cannot leave behind. Those things need to be removed before photos so they are not assumed they stay with the home. Example: Precious chandelier, TV mounts, expensive drapery hardware, wall mounted fireplace...

FRONT OF HOME

- ____Front door area is clean and all items removed, paint front door if needed
- ___Cars are out of driveway and garage doors are closed
- ____Toys, hoses, etc. all put away
- ____Driveway power washed if needed

BACK OF HOME

- ____All items off the ground and stored away
- ___Outdoor furniture staged to show off the entertaining options

__Patio power washed if needed

- Lawn mowed and landscaping trimmed
- ____Hide trash cans for photos if possible

KITCHEN

- ____Remove everything off the counters except one or two staging pieces
- Clear off all magnets and papers on refrigerator
- ___Stage the dining table by clearing off and hiding any baby seats/highchairs

LIVING ROOM

___Remove everything off of tables

___Use accent pillows on the furniture, vacuum off pet hair

___Clean out fireplace if needed

BATHROOMS

- ____Remove everything off the vanity and other surfaces
- ____Remove everything out of shower if it has see-through glass doors
- ___Clean toilets and put the seats down
- ____Hang only fresh and coordinating towels

BEDROOMS

- ____Make the beds with white or neutral bedding, add some accent pillows
- ____Remove everything off night stands and dressers
- ____Remove personalized wall hangings
